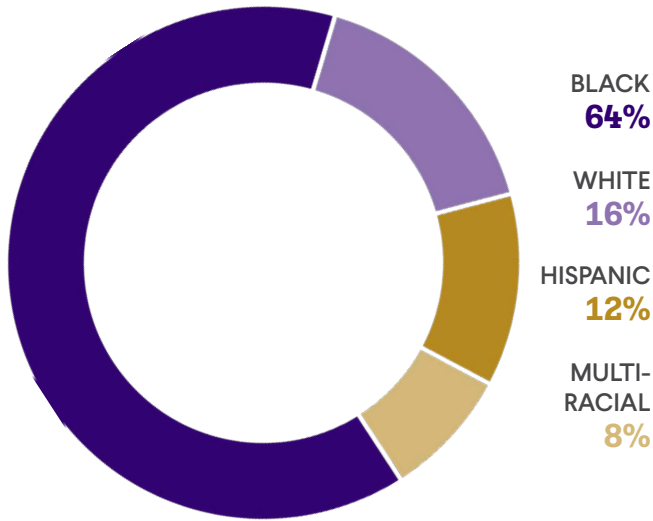

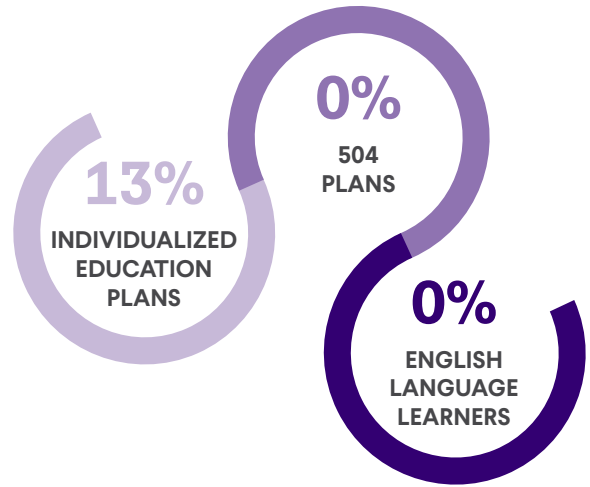

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



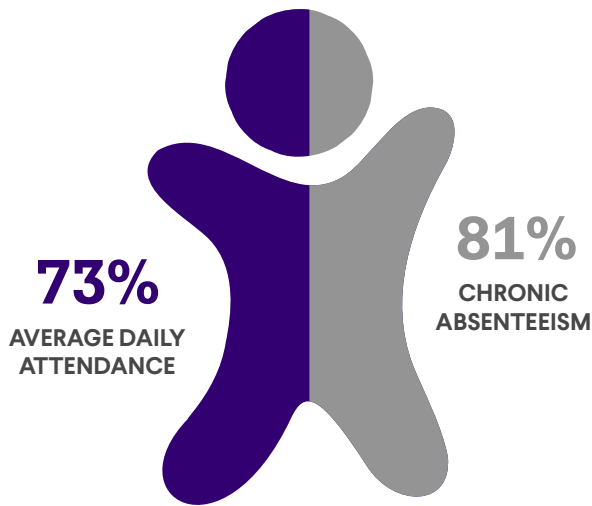

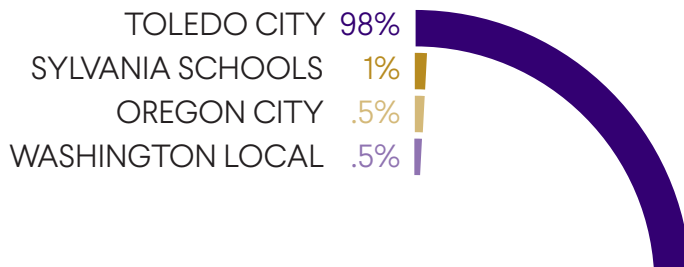

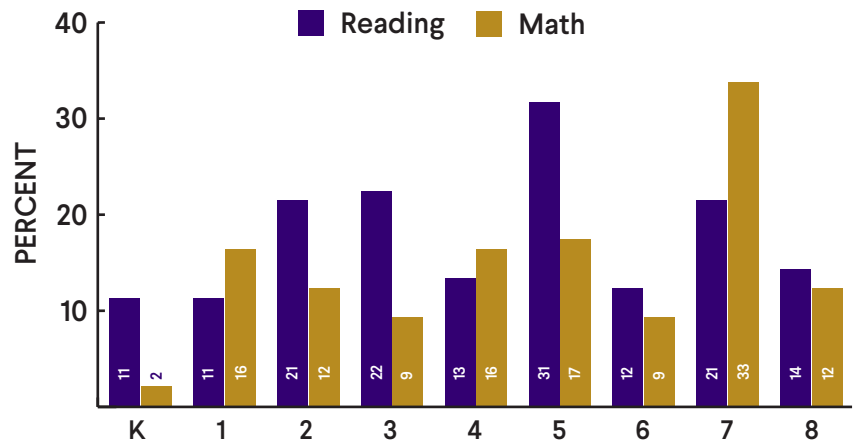

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

The academic goals of Toledo Preparatory Academy during the 2021-22 school year were to achieve an overall Performance Index score of 60 or higher, and 80% proficient on the Third Grade Reading test. Emerging from the pandemic, Toledo Prep fell short with a .67% increase to PI, but exceeded its Grade 3 promotion goal by close to 9%.

St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance. As a result of our thorough oversight and monitoring, St. Aloysius has determined that this school is substantially compliant with the rules and regulations governing community schools
